SPACE RENTAL OPPORTUNITIES

1ST FLOOR

ANNE & BERNARD SPITZER GRAND FOYER (MAIN LOBBY)

Dramatic first impressions that will amaze any visitor.

The Grand Foyer and entrance hallway provide an unforgettable first glance into the Museum's interior. Crafted from striking dark granite, Brazilian cherry wood, and Jerusalem stone, the space is the hub for all Museum activities and is among the most prominent of the Museum's public spaces. This 2,800-square-foot space is ideal for cocktail receptions as well as seated functions. It's the perfect setting in which to meet and greet your guests prior to functions in Edmond J. Safra Hall, or as a post-event gathering area. Capacity for this space is up to 300 guests.

EDMOND J. SAFRA HALL

Impressively designed state-of-the-art theater.

Edmond J. Safra Hall is Lower Manhattan's newest modern performance venue, ideal for productions ranging from musical events, panel discussions, conferences, symposia, lectures, presentations, film screenings, and ceremonial events. Rich in color and contemporary in architecture, Edmond J. Safra Hall is equipped with a stage, archive quality 35mm, 16mm and digital LCD projection, adjustable acoustic clouds, and customizable lighting design. The Hall is also home to the only Fazioli piano in a New York performance hall. The space can comfortably seat up to 375 guests.

MEETING ROOMS/CLASSROOMS

Comfortable lecture spaces with limitless possibilities.

These high-tech classrooms (460 square feet each) are perfect for such diverse functions as academic or business conference breakout sessions, board meetings, or small receptions. There are four individual classrooms that are 475 square feet each, or two combined classrooms that are 950 square feet each. Meeting rooms are equipped with an array of multi-media devices (slide, video, DVD, and LCD projection systems) and can accommodate your audio and video needs.

2ND FLOOR

LOBBY

City locale. Garden surroundings.

This primary space can be used to meet and greet guests for gatherings held in the main Events Hall. The lobby overlooks Andy Goldsworthy's *Garden of Stones*, which provides a peaceful and contemplative setting for visitors. This area can accommodate up to 800 guests when used in conjunction with the café and main Events Hall.

THE HERITAGE CAFÉ

Elegant dining in an intimate setting.

The Heritage Café is a dining facility featuring wood-grille windows and glass walls overlooking New York Harbor. The café highlights magnificent views of the Statue of Liberty and overlooks Andy Goldsworthy's *Garden of Stones*. The space is perfect for small receptions, intimate dinners, or it can be utilized in conjunction with the pre-function space for cocktails.

EVENTS HALL

The superlative venue for your next event.

This extraordinary 4,850-square-foot space with panoramic views is in demand as one of New York City's premier event venues. Featuring floor-to-ceiling windows with inspiring views of the Hudson, this custom-designed Events Hall has accents of Brazilian cherry wood, which complement an interior of tasteful glass columns and wood-bordered carpeted floors. There is also a 2,200-square-foot area adjacent to the Events Hall for cocktail hours and other pre-event gatherings.

The Events Hall suits both corporate and private events and can be used for seated functions, receptions, conferences, lectures, lifecycle celebrations, and more. The hall is fully equipped with LCD projection and can accommodate up to 450 guests.

3RD FLOOR

LOBBY / BRIDGE / TERRACE

Unique architecture provides a magnificent backdrop.

This locale can be used for gatherings where premier waterfront views and ethereal architecture can add to the glamour of your event. Overlooking Andy Goldsworthy's *Garden of Stones* and illuminated by James Carpenter's *Reflection Passage*, this flexible space can be used for indoor/outdoor affairs and can accommodate up to 150 guests for a seated reception or up to 250 guests for a less formal event.

4TH FLOOR

BOARD ROOM

Meeting space designed to inspire.

Have your next business retreat here and we're sure your attendees will come away enlightened by the experience and dazzled by the view. This 680-square-foot conference room offers a breathtaking 270 degree view of New York Harbor, the Statue of Liberty, and Ellis Island. This is the ideal backdrop to encourage creative thinking and provide inspiration for board meetings, brainstorming sessions, and retreats. The room seats 30 guests and has access to a screen and LCD projector, as well as a multi-line speaker phone for conference calls.
